Notes from 12/15/18 Meeting of Increased Involvement from Laity/Women Group

Reports from the four sub-groups:

- 1. Canon Law and the Laity
 - How can we have greater roles in the Diocese consistent with Canon Law?
 - What are best practices?
 - Can we influence changes with new bishops/pastors?
 - Can we appoint lay representatives to the vicariate?

2. Dallas Charter

- Outlines the structure currently operating
 - o Two trustees to oversee annual expenditures and sign off on annual report.
 - o Financial committee to advise the pastor.
 - o Parish Council to cooperate with the pastor on parish activities.
 - Voluntary and employed positions (receptionist, sacristans. Eucharistic ministers, lectors, altar servers, grievance committee, ushers, collection counters, music director, choir director and members, special lectures and programs, special liturgies and events.
 - o Parish school positions (principal, faculty, etc.)
- Outlines rights the laity already have
 - o Offer opinions
 - Be informed and consulted on major decisions
 - Limited preaching
 - o Teach
 - Limited ability to preside
 - Lay administrator duties, but with pastoral oversight
- Nothing exists at the Diocesan level
- Virtus requirement for volunteers
- No mandatory reporting requirements for abuse cases for parish officials in New York State.

3. Communications

- Need role definition; is the work limited to this workgroup, or the broader MRT?
- Target audience is the laity, not the Diocese
- Messages must be simple and action-oriented
- Message medium will be different depending upon the market
- Target markets include active movement Catholics, grass roots "in the pews" parishioners, top donors, parents, young people, disenfranchised Catholics.
- 4. Vatican II--Two core dogmatic constitutes
 - "Light of all nations"
 - o Church is the people of God
 - All are called to holiness
 - All are called to ministry
 - "Divine Revelation"
 - One Source of Revelation

- o God is personal and speaks the Word through Jesus
- o Opens the way for study and dialog with non-Christian people
